

Young people involved in Gangs.

Identification arrangements and monitoring system process flowchart:

Young person with gang involvement/links identified via:

- Community safety information;
- Weekly 'missing' meeting;
- ASB Case conference;
- Serious violence prevention panel (SVPP);
- YOS;
- MASE;
- MASH
- RSL's
- Probation
- Education

Agencies above should complete an early notification form (Appendix Bii) or referral direct to the Serious Violence Prevention Panel (Appendix Biii).



Community Safety lead fact finding/gatekeeping via:

- Profile of young person, location and alleged concerning or criminal behaviour;
- Information gathering across agencies and cross borough;
- Home visit.

After which, where appropriate the referral is accepted or signposted to a more appropriate agency or advice given
